Bunbury Boards

I can confirm that our company manufactures Bunbury Boards.

The Bunbury Boards are made from Irish hardwood timber using a range of species including oak, ash, elm, sycamore, birch, beech, sweet chestnut and other homegrown trees.

We only use timber from trees grown on the island of Ireland. The traceability number on the reverse side of the board identifies the exact location of the tree from which that particular board was made. This can be checked on-line at our website – www.bunbury.ie.

All timber used in the manufacture of Bunbury Boards is heat treated in our kiln driers to 10 % (+/-2%) Moisture Content before entering the workshop.

Our boards are exported around the world to several countries, including USA, Canada, Europe and Japan and they are accepted in those countries with no further treatment required.

Our boards are oiled with high-grade specialist oil that we create here in our workshop. It includes linseed oil, turpentine and orange oil.
